How to move Hot Folders for PitStop Server 7 and earlier installations?

Physical paths for all Hot Folder folders

First thing you need to do is to make sure that the physical hot folders are created in the same location as they are on the old computer. If they were on D://Hot Folders/Setup1, they should be created on D://Hot Folders/Setup1.

Hot Folder, Action List, PDF Profile definitions

Next thing to do is to copy all preferences that define the Hot Folder setup and the Action Lists / PDF Profiles databases. Depending on the platform you are working on, these preferences are saved in following locations:

WINDOWS

On Windows you need to copy 2 folders:

- The Enfocus Prefs Folder which contains the databases of Action Lists, PDF Profiles,
 ...
 - Path: 'C://WINDOWS/Enfocus Prefs Folders' or 'C://WINNT/Enfocus Prefs Folder'
- A second Enfocus Prefs which contains information about the hot folder setup of PitStop Server
 - Depending on the version of Windows you are running, you can find this folder in the location below. Be sure to know that this might be a hidden folder and that you'll have to enable the Windows option to show hidden files and folders.
 - o Windows 98: C://Windows/All Users/Application Data/Enfocus Prefs Folder
 - Windows NT: C://Winnt/Profiles/All Users/Application Data/Enfocus Prefs Folder
 - o Windows 2000: C://Documents and Settings/All Users/Application Data/Enfocus Prefs Folder
 - Windows XP: C://Documents and Settings/All Users/Application Data/Enfocus Prefs Folder



PitStop Server 4 and earlier

MAC OS9

On MacOS9, there is only 1 Enfocus Prefs Folder, located in the System:Preferences Folder. Copying this folder from the old to the new computer will do the trick.

MAC OSX

On Mac OS/X platform, you have two different folders to keep an eye on.

- The one that contains the PDF Profile templates, Action List and PDF Profile databases, PitStop System preferences and the color repository.
 Path: HD:Library:Preferences:Enfocus Prefs folder
- The one that contains the user preferences
 Path: HD:users:current user:Library:Preferences:Enfocus Prefs folder

Copy both folders to the appropriate paths located on the new machine. This way you'll be able to preserve all your preferences.
